Member Family Tickets

High Holy Day Ticket information will be mailed this summer. Members in good standing will receive one ticket each for parents and children from 2nd grade/7 years old through college/22 years old. Each ticket will be good for all services. You do not need tickets for children under 7 years old.

A minimum of 15% of your membership amount must be paid prior to Sept. 1, 2010 in order to receive your High Holy Day tickets.

Members must purchase guest tickets for children older than 22 years who are not full time students and for other family guests for \$100 each.

High Holy Day Guest Ticket Policy

Below are our policies for purchasing guest tickets:

- ★ Visitors and guests who are members of another Reform synagogue are welcomed. Synagogues have a reciprocity form which can be faxed to Temple Beth El confirming membership in good standing. These forms should be faxed to 704-366-1365.
- ★ Guest tickets are available for non members for \$200 each.
- ★ Families who resign their membership at Temple Beth El may not purchase guest tickets for 3 years after their resignation.

Full time students at all colleges and universities and members of the military will receive guest tickets at no charge.
