High Holy Day Guest Ticket Policy

All Temple Beth El families in good standing will receive a ticket for each adult member of the household including children from 2nd grade through 22 years old or a full time student.

Members must purchase guest tickets for children older than 22 years **who are not full time students** and for other family guests for \$100 each.

Visitors and guests who are members of another Reform synagogue are

welcomed. Synagogues have a reciprocity form which can be faxed to Temple Beth El confirming membership in good standing. These forms should be faxed to 704-366-1365.

Guest tickets are available for non-members for \$200 each.

Families who resign their membership at Temple Beth El may not purchase guest tickets for 3 years after their resignation.

Full time students **at all colleges and universities will receive guest tickets at no charge.**
